The Cuyama Valley received continuous rain starting the morning of Monday, January 9, 2023. The rain continued through the next two days. Driving conditions were hazardous and some of the roads were damaged due to the large sums of rain. Highway 166 closed from both Santa Maria and from Maricopa. On Friday, February 24, 2023, we had a blizzard warning and about 5 inches of snow at the school. Roads were closed as driving was hazardous for buses and vehicles alike. The district closed for three days. Jan. 10 and 11, & Feb. 24.
