School District Maximums

- ADA greater than 60,000 = \$4,500/month
- ADA greater than 25,000 but less than 60,000 = \$3,000/month
- ADA greater than 10,000 but less than 25,000 = \$2,000/month
- ADA greater than 1,000 but less than 10,000 = \$1,200/month
- ADA less than 1,000 = \$600/month

Notes

Summary of Legislation

- AB 1390 went into effect January 1, 2026.
- The bill increases the maximum compensation levels for county boards of education and school district governing boards.
- The legislation does not address health benefits for board members

Changes to Maximum Compensation Levels

- The maximum compensation level is based on the average daily attendance of the district or county
- There are 5 levels of school districts based on ADA
- School District maximums previously ranged from \$60/month to \$1,500/month (our largest district's max was \$400/month)
- School District maximums now range from \$600/month to \$4,500/month (our largest district's max is now \$2,000/month)
