This could include, but is not limited to, modifications to delivery of instruction, relocation of students and staff, continued daily student transportation during school closures, provision of alternative educational program options, provision for meals for students qualifying for Free and Reduced Lunch, possible temporary closure of one or more schools, adjustment to the school calendar, provision of leaves of absence for employees due to quarantine or recent return from
