4. Bond Series update and discussion on bond project AC/Heating at the Cuyama High School.

The CVHS is using portable heaters in the classrooms, and it has been using these heaters the last few years. The next project the board is looking at completing is the CVHS heating/air conditioning project.

5. Bond Activity for July through September 2022 and current balances

Terri King, Business Manager, informed the CBOC committee that the district has not had any activity during the first three months of the year. The \$5,000.00 expense was to pay the auditor for annual auditing services. The district has approximately

\$1,236,114.22 in the bond fund as of today, October 11, 2022. The Financial statement Fiscal 13a was provided to each CBOC committee member.
